

### Putting On & Styling Your Revlon Comb Add-On



Step 1: Pull your own hair back into a ponytail, just below the crown. For longer or thicker hair, make two ponytails, one above the other. Be sure to pin back any stray hairs.

Step 2: Remove the hairnet and hold the add-on by the combs. Shake gently to separate the fibers.

Step 3: Unlock the combs and place the teeth of the combs (centered) over your ponytail(s). Position the teeth downward into the ponytail, and close the combs tightly to lock in place. It should feel comfortable, yet secure.



Step 4: If needed, use a wide-tooth comb for styling and Revlon Styling Spray, which is suitable for your own natural hair too.

### Caring for Your Wig, Fall or Comb Add-On

The proper care of your hairpiece will keep it looking like new. Most women find it best to have a second hairpiece to use while allowing the proper time for cleaning and drying their first hairpiece.

Step 1: Use a shampoo specifically formulated to clean wigs, such as Revlon Texturizing Cleanser for synthetic hair. In a sink or

basin, mix a capful of wig shampoo in cool water and immerse your hairpiece. Let soak for a few minutes. Agitate gently and rinse in cool water until all shampoo is removed.

Step 2: Refill the sink or basin with clean, cool water and add a small amount of wig conditioner, such as Revlon Revitalizing Conditioner for synthetic hair. Immerse hairpiece and agitate gently. **DO NOT RINSE OUT CONDITIONER.** Remove hairpiece and gently comb through any tangles. Blot dry in a towel and then gently shake.

Step 3: Replace hairnet and allow your hairpiece to air dry on a wig stand or on top of a hairspray canister. Comb add-ons can be hung on a clothes line or hanger, with the combs locked together. **DO NOT BRUSH OR STYLE THE HAIRPIECE UNTIL IT IS COMPLETELY DRY.**

Step 4: Once dry, remove the hairnet. You will notice that the original style of your hairpiece has come back.

**IMPORTANT: DO NOT USE A HAIR DRYER, CURLING IRON OR ANY TYPE OF HEATED STYLING TOOLS ON SYNTHETIC HAIR. KEEP AWAY FROM ALL SOURCES OF HEAT OR OPEN FLAME.**

### Putting On Your Revlon Wig

Step 1: Remove and save the hairnet. Hold wig at the front hairline and gently shake to separate the fibers.

Step 2: Spray your wig with a light mist of room temperature water, and use your fingertips or a wide-tooth comb to style.

Step 3: Place your wig on a wig stand or on top of a hairspray canister until dry.



Step 4: Brush your own hair back, away from your face. For longer hair, pin it up so it is away from the front, sides and nape of your head.

A wig cap liner will help to keep it in place.

Step 5: Put your wig on from front to back. Adjust the position so the front edge of the wig is just over your own hairline.



Step 6: Use the ear tabs on the left and right side to center your wig. If your wig feels too tight or too loose, use the Velcro tabs at the back of the wig to adjust for the most comfortable fit. Tuck in any stray hairs and that's it.

### Wig Styling Tips

Revlon wigs are easy to manage and offer style flexibility. Each and every Revlon wig is inspected and re-styled by one of our trained beauticians before it's shipped to you.

The advanced construction and design techniques result in wigs that offer a tremendous number of styling options, and require very little attention...a quick finger combing or just a gentle shake-out before wearing is often all that is needed.

#### Here are a few styling tips from our Beauty Consultants:

- Don't try to get every hair in place. This can end up making the finest Revlon wig look "wiggly".
- If the style you've chosen offers flexibility, don't be afraid to try different looks using a good wig brush or styling comb.
- If you have a round or square shaped face, try to add height at the top while keeping the sides closer to your head.
- If you have a longer face, try to minimize height at the top and fluff up the sides.
- To hold the style in place, use a good wig spray such as Revlon Styling Spray for synthetic hair.

### Putting On & Styling Your Revlon Fall (3/4 Cap Hairpiece)



Step 1: Starting about 2 inches back from your own hairline that frames your face, comb the front of your hair forward.

Step 2: Pull back the rest of your hair into a small ponytail or use bobby pins to keep in place. For longer hair, secure with 2-3 flat pincurls.

Step 3: Remove hairnet. Hold your hairpiece at the front and gently shake to separate the fibers.

Step 4: Secure the front comb on the crown of your head at the point where you have separated your hair. Stretch the bottom comb down and anchor it at the nape of your neck.

Step 5: Blend your own hair with the hairpiece by brushing or teasing your own hair over the hairpiece.

Use a wide-tooth comb for styling and Revlon Styling Spray to hold the style.



You now have long luxurious hair with a natural look and feel.
